This is a challenge quilt for a quilt show in Baja Mexico on the Sea Of Cortez where we have a little vacation house.

20 **Natural Juice Bar and Deli**
42031 Main Street Suite A
Kumbaya 33" x 33" Pieced and machine quilted by Marcy Boswell.

This quilt, made entirely from stash fabric, reminded me of sitting around the campfire holding hands and singing.

42031 Main Street Suite B
Marcie's Retirement Adventure 31" x 26" Designed, machine pieced, appliquéed, embellished & machine quilted by Cheri McDowell.

To honor the memory of our Welsh Terrier, Marcie, who came to live with us at 8 years old. She brought us joy, love & laughter for another 6 years in return for a happy retirement home! This was made for a quilt challenge titled "All Things Bright, Beautiful & Quilted".

28459 Old Town Front Street

Diamonds on her Soles 15" x 15" Embroidered with various color threads, yarn, baubles, beads and crystals by Laura Haskell
Leora Raikin sells African folklore embroidery needlecraft to raise awareness of the craft. A friend gave me a blank KuKu bird to challenge my creativity! I finished the challenge and to me, she looks like a pretty ku ku !

2 **Sugar Babies**
28465 Old Town Front Street

Sugar and Spice 48" x 36" Machine pieced and hand appliquéd by Jane Ward. Machine quilted by Janiel Miller.
This was made for my first granddaughter. I wanted something pink and feminine.

3 **Vintage Begonia**
28465 Old Town Front Street #102

Orange Sherbet 78" x 78" Machine pieced by Jane Ward. Machine quilted by Janiel Miller.
I was drawn to the color combinations in this Moda Fabric collection. When the quilt was done, it reminded me of orange sherbet.

4 **Silver Fever**
28475 Old Town Front Street "A"

Midnight Garden 16 3/4" x 16 3/4" Fused applique, machine pieced, and machine quilted by Sara Kalinin
It was very liberating to free form cut these flowers. The bright colors against the black fabric made them really pop.

5 **The Little Viking**
28480 C Old Town Front Street

Christmas Ornaments 38" x 50" Pieced, embellished and quilted by Clydene Sigle.
Gold/ green/ red/ silver/blue ornaments with trim enhance this quilt to make a holiday wall hanging. A ribbon here and there makes it a festive quilt to hang for the holidays. I had made larger quilts of this pattern, but wanted to do a miniature of this pattern. What an enjoyment for the holiday season.

Stop and Smell the Roses 27" x 27" machine appliquéd & pieced by Sandy Besanson, machine quilted by Suzzane Borchers.

This is my cat leisurely taking a walk through a rose garden. Do you think maybe he has a bird stuck in his mouth ?? Accidentally on purpose?? He looks pretty contented to me.

Jazzy 27"x24" machine appliquéd & quilted by Sandy Besanson.

At The Candy Store 28" x32"
I saw this pattern in a kit with all the candy fabrics and just had to make it. Paper pieced and machine quilted by Gloria Bachmann.

Heavenly Strawberries 20 3/4 " x 25 1/2" Fused applique, machine pieced, and machine quilted by Sara Kalinin
After my brother's passing, I couldn't help wondering what heaven was like. I imagined angels sitting around eating chocolate-covered strawberries!

Happy Vibrations 40" x 46" Machine pieced and machine quilted by Sara Kalinin.
I love the way the fabrics are dancing together. There's definitely a party going on here!

My Wine Country 42" x 42" Machine-pieced, machine-appliqued and machine quilted by Patti Zimmerman

Brazilian Poppy 30" X 35" Fused, machine appliquéd and machine quilted with threadplay, by Carole Donahoe.
Using Melinda Bula's "Renegade Threadplay" technique, I painted with thread for the first time, and loved it! Ole!

Easter Star 24" x 24" Machine pieced by Gail Ledbetter, machine quilted by Liz Buelow, embellished with heat set crystals.

I started this quilt in a Carol Doak workshop and after much trial and error finally finished it. I now feel fairly comfortable with this technique.

Queen of the Rodeo 52" x 65" Pieced and quilted by Janis Pearson. Owner: Sheryl Eramo.

Using a variety of western fabrics, including pictures of cowgirls and western kerchiefs, Janis captures the feeling of the rough and ready cowgirls.

Bradley's Big Brother Quilt 41" x 49" Designed, machine pieced and machine quilted by Carole Donahoe.
